Types of Points a Delegate

can rise to:

Point of Parliamentary Inquiry - A delegate rises to this point if he/she has a clarification regarding the “Rules of Procedure” of the event.

Point of Information - A delegate rises to this point if he/she wants to ask a question to another delegate regarding their speech/stance.

Point of Order - A delegate rises to this point if he/she wants to point out a factual error in another delegate’s speech

Point of Personal Privilege - A delegate rises to this point if he/she has an issue or a question regarding themselves, which is strictly not part of the committee proceedings.

Plead to follow up - A delegate rises to this point if he/she wants to reply to a point raised against them or to simply follow up a point risen by another delegate.
